PAYMENT OF FEES:

- 1. Students are required to pay full fess for the whole year at the time of securing admission to The college.
- 2. No Leaving Certificate will be issued to any student unless he/she has paid all the college dues (including, in the case of a resident student, all hostel and mess dues.)

3. In case of student leaves the course in between (first year) he is bound to pay second year fees.
